Dear Props. 94 through 97 supporter:

As leaders of the four tribes whose amended compact agreements were recently brought before California voters, we want to thank you for standing with us and dozens of other Native American tribes in your support of Propositions 94, 95, 96 & 97. On February 5, California voters convincingly supported the Indian Gaming Agreements on our statewide ballot.

In doing so, California voters yet again demonstrated their support for Indian gaming on existing tribal lands and in support of Indian self-reliance. Voters also demonstrated their support for agreements that will provide:

- **Hundreds of millions of dollars each year in new revenues for California;**
- **Tens of millions each year in funding to help tribes with little or no gaming;**
- **New protections for our environment, casino employees, local governments and taxpayers to offset the impacts of gaming in local communities.**

We were proud to be supported by so many leading Californians and California organizations. Hundreds of groups representing police officers, emergency medical personnel and firefighters, taxpayers, business and labor, educators, Indian Tribes, elected officials, seniors and religious organizations joined us in supporting the new agreements.

Support from organizations and individuals was absolutely critical in educating the voters and ultimately in gaining voter approval for these important measures.

Again, we want to thank you for standing with us in support of the Indian Gaming Agreements. Now that these agreements are in place, we look forward to upholding our promise by enacting the new protections and providing California with much-needed revenues.
